Parent Notification of Academic Intervention Services

GRCHS Parents:

To further advance GRC's mission of *All Students: College and Career Ready*, we are providing extra support to students who did not meet grade-level achievement in reading and math, as well as to those who have not met mastery of content in certain areas.

To comply with Senate Bill (SB) 1 and support district-wide efforts to improve student achievement, all Clark County Public School students are given assessments three times each year to measure progress and mastery of skills and curriculum over time. The results of these assessments are used to identify students who need intervention.

These interventions work in one of two ways. Some students are being pulled from specified elective periods a few times a week to receive extra support. Others are actually enrolled in an intervention class, which is noted on your child's schedule as an elective course.
