Minutes for August 7, 2023

The George Rogers Clark High School SBDM council met on August 7, 2023, at 4:00 p.m. in the school library. The following were present:

Mr. Toy called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. and welcomed all that were in attendance.

Mrs. Gay made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Mrs. Greenwell. Motion passed.

Mrs. Greenwell made a motion to approve the minutes for May 1, 2023; second by Mrs. Gay . Motion passed.

Mrs. Greenwell made a motion to correct the spelling of Jill Bonfield name on the minutes for July 20, 2023; second by Mrs. Gay. Motion passed. Mrs. Greenwell then made a motion to approve the July 20th minutes, second by Mrs. Harper. Motion passed.

In Good News, Mr. Toy said that the Kagan training was going well. Mrs. Greenwell stated that it works well in the classroom.

There were no public comments.

Mr. Toy talked with the council about SBDM Bylaws and Policy Review. Which one should be reviewed and how often? It was decided that the administration should study the Bylaws this year and bring the ones to SBDM as needed. Policy review will be done next year.

Mr. Toy presented the budget report. The ESSER account started with \$588,000 this year. Those funds have been used for two math teachers, an English teacher, two substitute teachers, a science teacher and an at-risk advisor. There is \$130,000 remaining. Mrs. Gay made a motion to approve the budget, second by Mrs. Greenwell. Motion passed.

In new business, the council acknowledged receipt of managing government records, the Kentucky open records, open meetings act, KRS 158-183, and KRS 158.195.

Mr. Toy announced that iReady will be given during the first two weeks of September. The scores are necessary to determine interventions.
