Clark County Staff and Families;

Clark County Public Schools would like to inform our staff and families of our processes for communicating positive COVID-19 test results of staff and students.

Upon notification of possible positive or positive COVID-19 test results, we contact the Clark County Health Department and begin working with their staff on next steps. We support the health department in its handling of the processes and the appropriate notifications. Health department staff begin reaching out, interviewing, and providing assistance directly to individuals with elevated risk of exposure because they may have been in recent, close contact with the staff member and/or student. All staff and families directly impacted by this news are contacted by the health department. If staff and/or families feel that they have been exposed to COVID-19 and have not been contacted, we ask that they call the Clark County Health department with questions and concerns at 859.744.4482.

As soon as a positive COVID-19 test result is verified by the health department, the school administrator at the particular location is provided a letter communicating the positive COVID-19 test result. The administrator posts the letter on the school's website and distributes the letter to staff. Staff and families should continue to monitor their school's websites for daily updates of new positive COVID-19 test results.
