Minutes for the February 5, 2024

The George Rogers Clark High School SBDM met on February 5, 2024, at 4:30 in the school library. The following were present:

Mr. Toy called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. The Council decided to change the start time to 4:30 for the rest of the school year.

Mr. Toy took attendance, Erin Newton was not present.

Mr. Williamson asked to add graduation requirements to the agenda. After a short discussion Mr. Williamson made a motion to include graduation requirements on the agenda, second by Mrs. Harper. Motion passed.

A mistake was made in the minutes for January - Amazing Shake was spelled with an h not an n. Mrs. Ros made a motion to approve the change and approve the minutes, second by Mr. Williamson. Motion passed.

Good News included basketball for special need students and a great turn out for the Soiree (around 300 students at the Opera House).

There were no public announcements.

KCSS results are in. It was a fairly good outcome, however, we have a lot of work to do. Technology was the only area to go up. They scored 73%. Ninety-five students and ten parents participated in this survey.

Safety and Impact Survey results came back in November. We have a lot of work to do here also. Mr. Toy decided to wait until after Christmas to share the results. The teachers will receive these scores at a staff meeting.

The agenda called for a second reading of the Dance Policy. However, changes were made first. Alternative school kids will need approval from their principal and an administrator from Phoenix must chaperone. Students with three or more ISAP's will not be allowed to attend dances. Students having ten or more unexcused absences to school will not be able to attend dances. These decisions are only for the current school year. Mr. Williamson made a motion to approve these changes to the Dance Policy, second by Mrs. Greenwell. Motion passed.

Council discussed a revising of the Scheduling Policy. When students want to change a class, they will meet with their counselor first and then to their principal if it is necessary. Mrs. Greenwell made a motion to rename Scheduling Policy to Student Body Scheduling Assignment, second by Mrs. Gay. Motion passed.
