We were able to hire a new teacher with Title 1 funds. We had our Title 1 Night at the beginning of the school year.

Our attendance has not been high enough so far this year. In September, our attendance was 90.8%. Our goal is to reach 95% each month. We are working on incentives.

Council considered the September Finance Report. Purchase orders have to be signed by the department head. Mrs. Gay made a motion to approve the finance report, second by Mr. Collins. Motion passed.

The Board of Education wants to revise the Principal Selection Policy. It had not been reviewed for some time. The BOE sent what they wanted with the superintendent having the final decision. After discussion, Mr. Williamson made a motion to approve the policy, second by Mrs. Gay. Motion passed.
