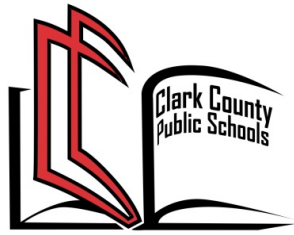

Clark County Public Schools' Stakeholders;

Due to a marked increase in student and staff COVID-19 cases, and after consultation with the Clark County Health Department, I am **suspending** our In-Person Hybrid instruction until after the Thanksgiving holiday. The number of positive cases and other contributing factors in our schools and community have continued to increase. The Clark County Health Department continues to calculate the Clark County infection rate as in "Red status". Our local numbers will not be reflected on the state website until all local cases are confirmed at the state level. We will continue to evaluate the community case numbers daily. At this time, **all students** will continue with distance learning instruction through **Tuesday, November 24, 2020**, our last school day before Thanksgiving break.

We will continue to work with our local health department using COVID-19 daily updates regarding Clark County's current status to assess what is best for the safety of all stakeholders. You will be notified of a possible In-Person return date before November 30, depending on the Clark County infection rate status.

All students will continue with Distance Learning until In-Person instruction resumes. Student participation is still a requirement for attendance purposes. During this time, while in the "red," all winter sports athletic events and practices, extracurricular activities, and small group instruction in Clark County will be cancelled. Staff will continue to report to their buildings at regular times unless individual arrangements are made with building administrators.

Families may continue to pick up meals between 11:30 am and 1:00 pm Monday through Friday at any of our school locations *excluding Preschool and Phoenix*. This meal schedule will continue regardless of In-Person or Distance Learning.

Stopping the increase of local cases and in order to provide our students with In-Person instruction will require all of us working together as a community. Please continue to avoid crowds, stay at home when possible, wear masks, regularly wash hands, and maintain at least six feet of distance from others. Refer to Clark County Public Schools' websites and social media accounts for updates and current school activity changes.
