- C. Approval of Budget - Motion made by Mrs. Pigg, seconded by Mrs. Gay passed after brief discuss on supplies for students and teachers by department.
- D. Handbook Revisions - Motion by Mrs. Harper, seconded by Mrs. Pigg approved the revisions to the handbook after discussions below including asking for better signage for traffic patterns and parking. Then SRO at ATC entrance and adding email link to FRYSC contact.

- E. New Policy
Seal of Arts Excellence (First Reading) Mr. Olson presented and council had first reading of the policy.
- F. Bell Schedule - A.P. Mrs. Cook explained new scheduled with changes of rolling lunch and extra advisory time during 4th period. Lunch will cut approx. 150 students off every 7 min. To make lines move quicker. Members of council asked that A.P. have discussion with cafe' and custodial staff before change is made. Motion made by Mrs. Reeder, seconded by Mrs. Pigg to remove table. Motion made by Mrs. Reeder, seconded by Mrs. Harper to approve Handbook Revisions if Tina Brooks approves bell changes for Cafe'
