Mr. Toy called the meeting to order at 4:52 p.m. Erin Newton and Amy Harper were absent.

Mrs. Greenwell made a motion to approve the agenda, second by Mrs Gay. Motion passed.

Mrs. Gay made a motion to approve the minutes for December 4, 2023, second by Mr. Williamson. Motion passed.

Good News included Christmas shopping for 80 students - lunch and shopping at Walmart with \$80 each. The kids bought things for themselves and for others. Amazing Shake is a new program that is open for 5th to 8th grade students.

Terra Pigg, an agriculture teacher at GRC, used public comments to promote a seven period schedule next year. She is an elective teacher and knows how important these classes are to the students.

Mr. Lennon, Youth Services Director, informed the council of the status of his program. Funds for the program have been lower for a couple of years. However, he started the year with \$400, then someone left the program and he now has \$4000. These funds can be used for after school tutoring, travel, cap and gown help, lunch for “mom class “ lunches, college fair incentives/reward programs, and clothing for the YSC students.

Representing the counseling office, Mrs. Williamson reported that the counselors want to establish policies for changing classes. This should provide the information for students to advocate for themselves. They plan to start scheduling for next year in February.
