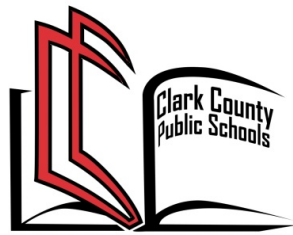

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The health, safety, and well-being of students and staff remain our highest priority as we navigate this public health crisis. We will continue to follow sound protocols aligned with guidance and support from state and local health officials to ensure we are doing everything we can to protect the health of our students, staff, and community.

Multiple criteria assist us in choosing the learning model that should be in place district-wide. One determining factor is the COVID-19 seven-day incident rate for our county. The information may be viewed at any time by going to the [COVID19.Ky.gov](https://COVID19.Ky.gov) website. If Clark County is highlighted in "**RED**," it is due to the widespread positivity of COVID-19. If our county is "**RED**," we will return immediately to Distance Learning for all students at all schools.

Additionally, if we are "**RED**," **all** athletic events and practices, extra-curricular activities, and in-person small group instruction will be canceled until further notice. A one-call notification will be sent through Infinite Campus Messenger just like a "snow day." We will also post the information on all District and school websites and social media sites. Staff will report to their buildings at their regular times, unless other arrangements are made with building administration.

All families may continue to pick up meals at any of our school locations (excluding Hannah McClure Preschool and Phoenix Academy) from 11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. This meal schedule will continue regardless of In-person or Distance Learning.

To help stop the increase of local cases and return our students to In-person instruction, it will take all of us working together as a community. Please continue to follow all the CDC and Clark County Health Department guidelines. Continue to view all Clark County Public Schools' social media accounts for updates and current school activity changes. I will continue to work with our local Health Department for COVID-19 daily updates regarding Clark County's current status and what is best for all stakeholders' safety.
